INGREDIENTS

Wheat middlings, soybean hulls, corn distillers dried grains with solubles, molasses products, dehydrated alfalfa meal, retail beet pulp, soybean oil, soybean meal, calcium carbonate, salt, calcium phosphate, sodium carboxymethylcellulose, zinc proteinate, choline chloride, vitamin E supplement, manganese proteinate, dried seaweed meal, copper proteinate, *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* yeast culture, brewers dried yeast, rice hulls, hydrolyzed yeast, propionic acid (a preservative), sorbic acid (a preservative), acetic acid (a preservative), benzoic acid (a preservative), selenium yeast, calcium pantothenate, mineral oil, niacin supplement, thiamine mononitrate, cobaltproteinate, riboflavin supplement, menadione nicotinamide bisulfite (source of vitamin K activity), vitamin A supplement, pyridoxinehydrochloride, vitamin B-12 supplement, folic acid, vitamin D-3 supplement, ethylenediamine dihydroiodide, biotin.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

Feed Cool Command Controlled Starch Pellet to horses that require a low source of carbohydrates according to the chart below with good quality hay/pasture (1.0 – 2 lbs/100 lbs of body weight), free choice mineral and fresh, clean water.

Maintenance	5.0 – 6.0 lbs
Performance Light	6.0 – 7.0 lbs
Performance Moderate	7.0 – 9.0 lbs
Performance Heavy	8.0 – 10.0 lbs
Early Gestation	3.5 – 8.0 lbs
Late Gestation	6.0 – 10 lbs
